



<p>Task 1 Reading Share your favourite bedtime story (or dinosaur book for Spring 2) with an adult. Tell your adult why it is your favourite. Add a photo and caption of what your child says.</p>	<p>Task 2 Writing Draw a picture of a nocturnal animal (or dinosaur for Spring 2). Reception: Can you sound out and write any letters you hear (e.g. b-a-t, f-o-x)? Bring into class to show your friends.</p>	<p>Task 3 Phonics Go on a letter/sound hunt at home. What letters/ sounds can you spot? Can you notice them in the books you read? Have an adult take a photo or caption of some letters/ sounds you find.</p>	<p>Task 4 Maths Nursery: Can you spot and count a group of 1, 2 or 3 objects? Take a photo and add onto Tapestry. Reception: Can you count groups of 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 objects. Can you write the numbers with support from an adult? Bring into class to show your friends.</p>
<p>Task 5 R.E. Have a look at a children's Bible, nativity or another religious storybook. Let your child explore some of the pictures and talk about what they like. Add a photo and caption of what your child says or bring book into class.</p>	<p>Task 6 Understanding the World Can you draw a picture of a winter/spring scene? Bring into class to show your friends.</p>	<p>Task 7 Shape Find an example of a 2-D circle, triangle, square and rectangle in your environment. Reception: Can you find a 3-D shape?</p>	<p>Task 8 Understanding the World (History) Have a chat with your mum/dad or any grandparents you may have. Do they have any special 'winter' or 'spring' memories?</p>
<p>Task 9 Understanding the World (Geography) Go for a nighttime walk or have a hot chocolate picnic in the back garden (bundle up). Can you see or hear any nocturnal animals? What do you notice in the nighttime sky? Take a photo of you and your child.</p>	<p>Task 10 Physical Development Make an obstacle course at home with pillows and cushions. Pretend you are a polar animal (or dinosaur for Spring 2) jumping from ice block to ice block (or lava). How does your animal (dinosaur) get around? Have an adult take a photo of you as a polar animal (or dinosaur).</p>	<p>Task 11 Computing Can you type and search on the computer/laptop/ tv device: 'w-i-n-t-e-r a-n-i-m-a-l-s' with adult support? What nature programs can you find?</p>	<p>Task 12 Music Listen to a classic lullaby or sing a lullaby at bedtime with an adult. What instruments can you hear? How does it make you feel?</p>
